PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2021

The above Order made on 16th December 2021 will extinguish the part of Public Footpath X31 (part) in the Parish of Misterton with Walcote and the District of Harborough, shown by a bold continuous line on Plan No. 2558 annexed hereto, which extends from point "A" on the plan, situate at its western-most junction with the A4304 Lutterworth Road at Grid Reference 45592 28352, in generally east-south-easterly and east-north-easterly directions following the southern boundary of the A4304 Lutterworth Road through woodland, for a total distance of approximately 480 metres to point "B" on the plan, situate at its eastern-most junction with the A4304 Lutterworth Road at Grid Reference 45638 28357.

The short section of Public Footpath X16 that crosses Footpath X31 in order to gain access to the A4304 Lutterworth Road (and is thus co-existent with it) shall not be stopped up.

The section of Footpath X31 to be stopped up has no recorded width.

A copy of the Order and map has been placed and may be seen free of charge at Room 200 Main Building, County Hall, Glenfield, Leicestershire, LE3 8RA and the offices of Harborough District Council, Symington Building, Adam & Eve Street, Market Harborough, Leicestershire, LE16 7AG during office opening hours. A copy has also been sent to the Parish Council for Misterton with Walcote. Copies of the Order and map may be purchased at a cost of £15.

Any representation about or objection to the Order may be sent in writing to me at the undermentioned address quoting reference RJ/ HTWMT/4592 not later than 20th January 2022. Please state the grounds on which it is made.

If no such representation or objection is duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Leicestershire County Council may confirm the Order as unopposed. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representation or objection which has not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
